The successful applicant for this position provides comprehensive client-centered support to individuals who have been diagnosed with a serious and persistent mental illness, conducts presentations to promote mental health and the understanding of mental health and illness, and provides community outreach, finding methods to reach out to individuals in the community who could benefit from our services.

Candidates must possess a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology. A belief in recovery and the ability to establish supportive trusting relationships with persons with serious mental illness are essential qualities, as is the ability to collaborate and contribute to the positive culture of the team. A valid driver's license and use of a reliable vehicle are required.
