

Maintenance Contractor – Part Time

It is the responsibility of the landlord, CMHA, to provide maintenance services to all tenants of the building. CMHA is seeking to contract the services of a Maintenance Contractor to perform general building maintenance and repairs.

Responsibilities:

- Inspect and perform quality controls of facilities including mechanical, plumbing and electrical systems
- Troubleshoot, resolve, and/or make recommendations of problem areas
- Complete routine checks of the property
- Provide recommendations for renovations, if/when required
- General duties may include minor repairs and maintenance, changing light bulbs, unplugging toilet, repairing drywall, touch up paint, and other duties as assigned.
- Coordinate work with external sources when required
- Identify possible health and safety hazards
- Maintain positive relationships with clients, tenants, and landlord

Requirements:

- Knowledge of building automation system and HVAC system.
- Knowledge of plumbing and electrical
- Knowledge of municipal codes
- Knowledge of health and safety standards

The Maintenance Contractor shall provide their own tools and must have a valid license and vehicle. The successful applicant will be required to provide a criminal reference check.

Applications should detail experience and qualifications.
